Study on the impacts of climate change on employment

In its conclusions one can read that *"According to an estimate of the employment content of the emissions reduction options, **the overall balance of jobs in the branches that will expand and in those where activity will be reduced does not appear negative and may even be positive.** Compared to the trend scenario, the overall net gain in employment for the sectors covered by the study would be of the order of 1.5%"*

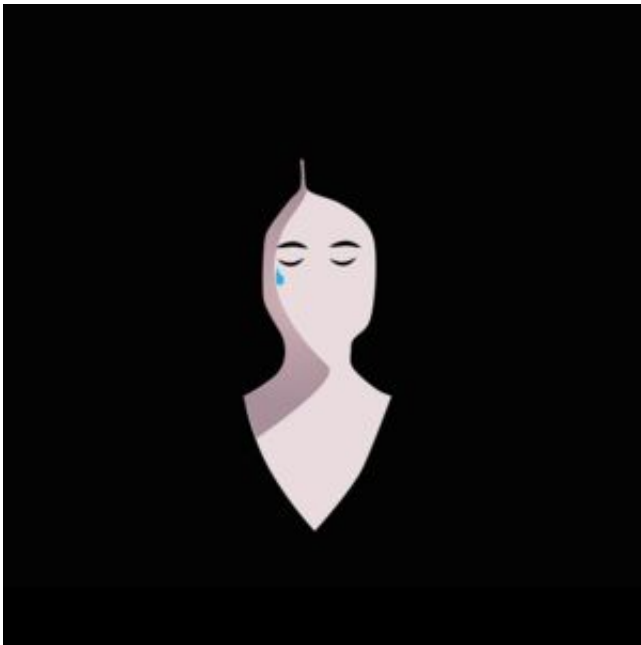
