With this attack, Russia is not only perpetuating its genocidal policy against Ukrainians but also committing ecocide. We must support investigations into criminal accountability for Russia's violation of the laws of war.

"The Greens/EFA Group are calling for targeted long-term assistance to mitigate the severe damage to the natural environment and population health. The EU needs to invest in the sustainable reconstruction of Ukraine, to design for the recovery of a clean and green Ukraine, underpinned by the European Green Deal."
