Motto 'never forget' should ring loud and clear in today's Europe

In a statement on the seventieth anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau extermination camp, Greens/EFA co-president **Rebecca Harms** and EP vice-president **Ulrike Lunacek**, who represented the European Parliament at the ceremony in Auschwitz, said:
