Nobel committee gives timely reminder to EU of its strengths

Commenting on the award of the 2012 Nobel Peace Prize to the European Union, Greens/EFA co-president **Rebecca Harms** said:

"The decision of the Nobel committee is both surprising and brave. The EU, while imperfect and incomplete, is still a unique project for peace and unity. The award is also a timely reminder to the EU of its strengths at this time of crisis."

Greens/EFA co-president **Dany Cohn-Bendit**, added:

"It is right for the EU to celebrate this award but it must take this peace mission seriously and push to ensure the EU gains a seat on the UN Security Council as a peaceful power.
