Greens/EFA co-president Philippe Lamberts, who will speak for the group in the debate, comments:

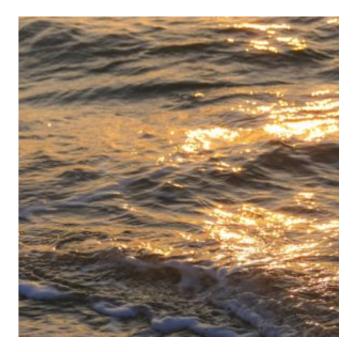

The European Parliament has already put forward strong proposals that would do a great deal to alleviate the suffering of refugees and ease pressure on countries like Italy and Greece.
