"By granting candidate status, EU ministers have taken a consequential step to revive the accession process and regain trust and credibility in the Western Balkans, after neglecting the region for years."

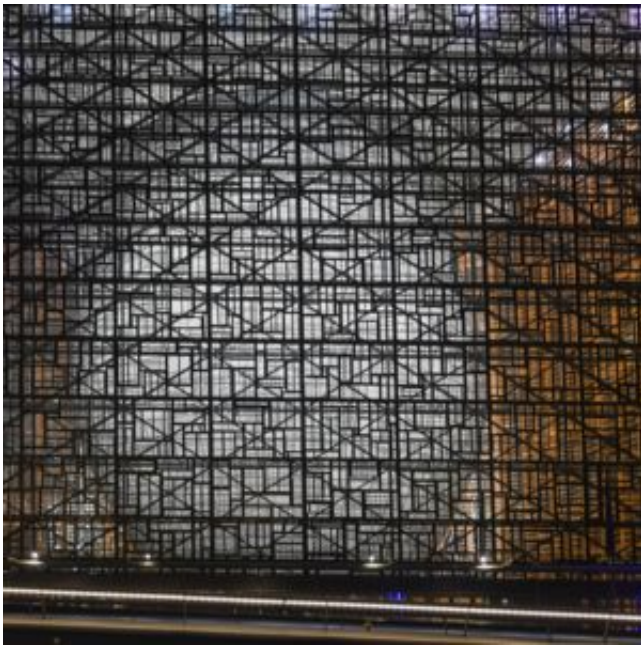
"Despite a lack of progress by Bosnia and Herzegovina political actors, this is an important sign of commitment towards the citizens, also in light of the changed geopolitical context."
