"Despite a lack of progress by Bosnia and Herzegovina political actors, this is an important sign of commitment towards the citizens, also in light of the changed geopolitical context."


"It is now essential to urge Bosnia and Herzegovina politicians to take responsibility and implement much needed democratic reforms so further steps can be taken in the accession process."
