

Measure taken by the Polish authorities that further destroy the rule of law in Poland since the outbreak of the war in Ukraine:

- on February 25, 2022 Polish judge Anna Głowacka was suspended for applying European law and the judgments of the European courts.
- the President handed out appointments to more than 200 new, defectively nominated (at the request of the neo-NCJ) so-called neo judges, including 4 appointments to the Supreme Court.
- on 10 March 2022, at the request of the Minister of Justice Zbigniew Ziobro, the politicized and fully subordinated Constitutional Tribunal (with the participation of so-called "stand-in judges") undermined the validity of Article 6 of the ECHR in Poland by questioning the ability of the ECtHR and Polish courts to examine the correctness of the appointment of judges and the independence of the neo-NCJ.
