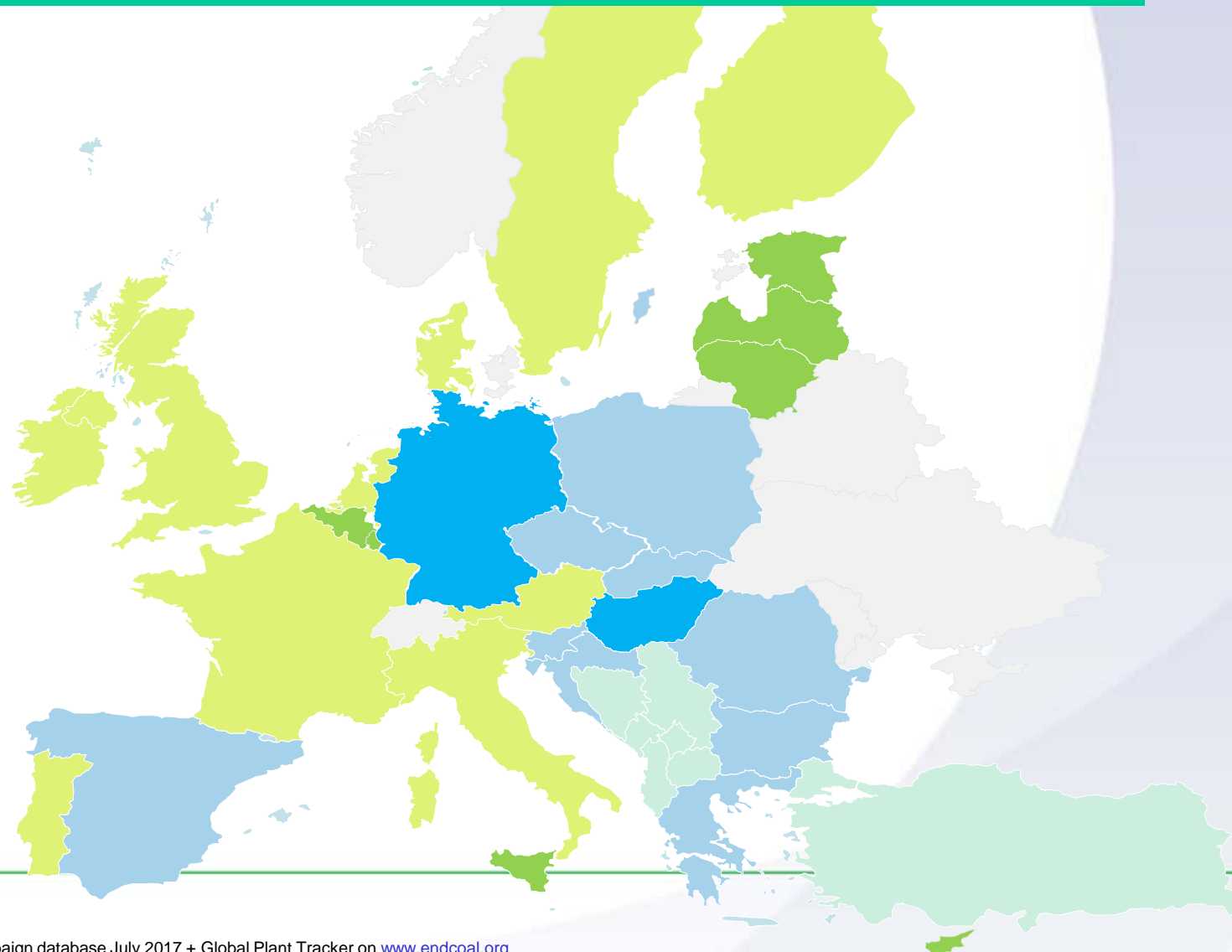
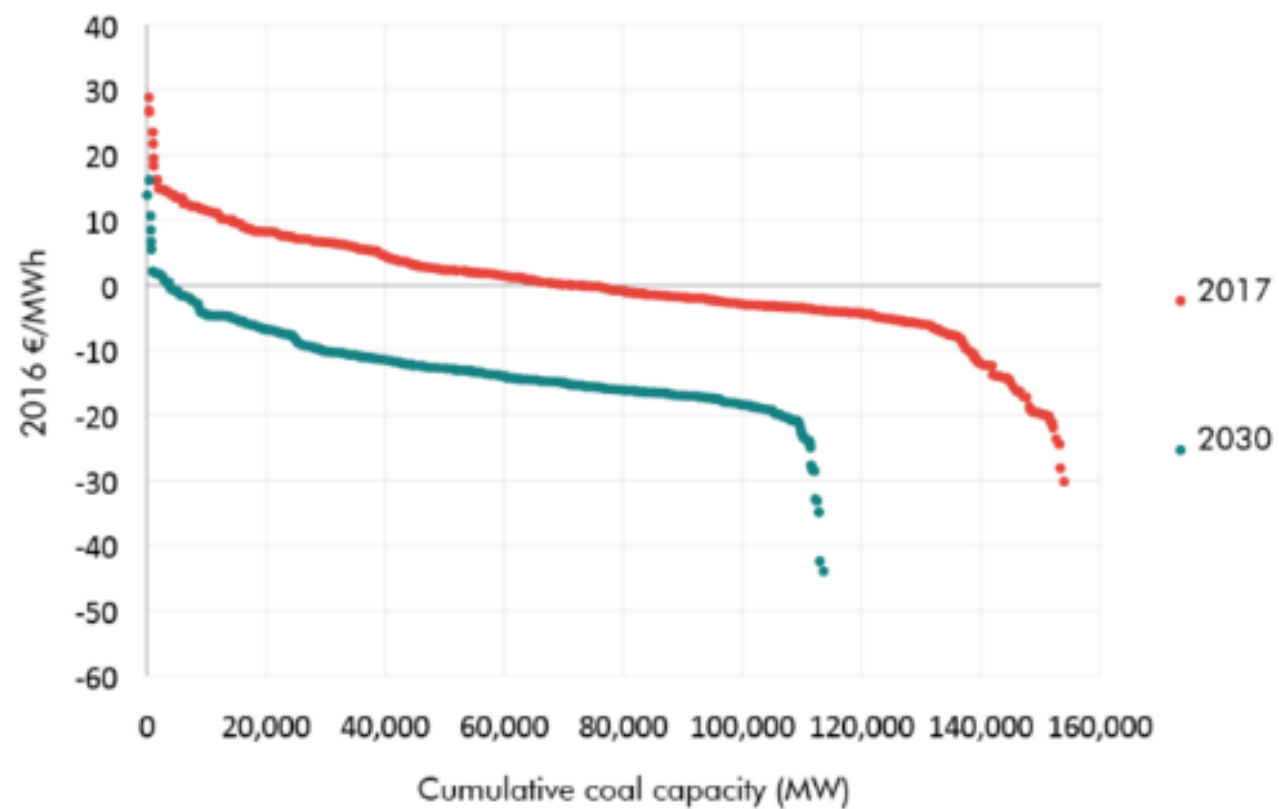




Which EU countries are phasing out coal?



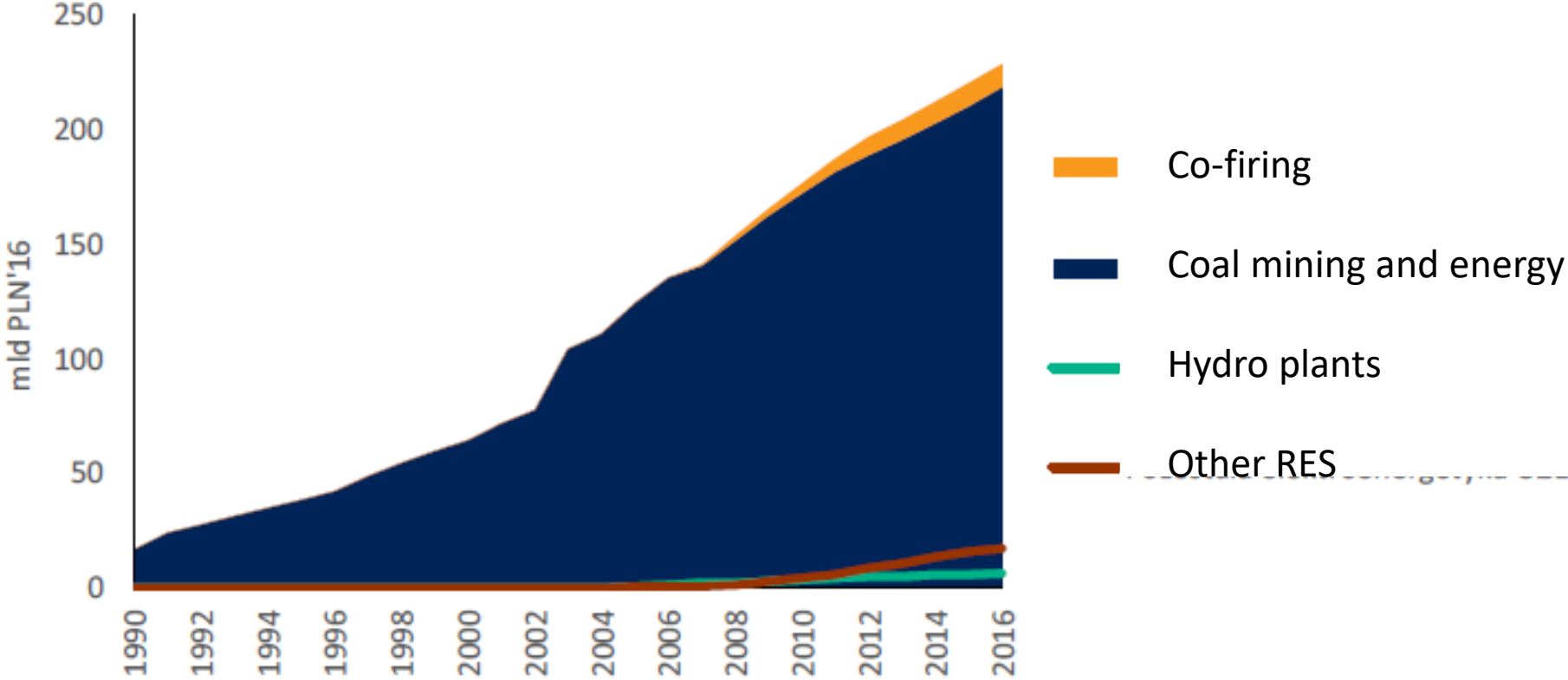
Gross profitability of operating coal fleet in 2017 and 2030

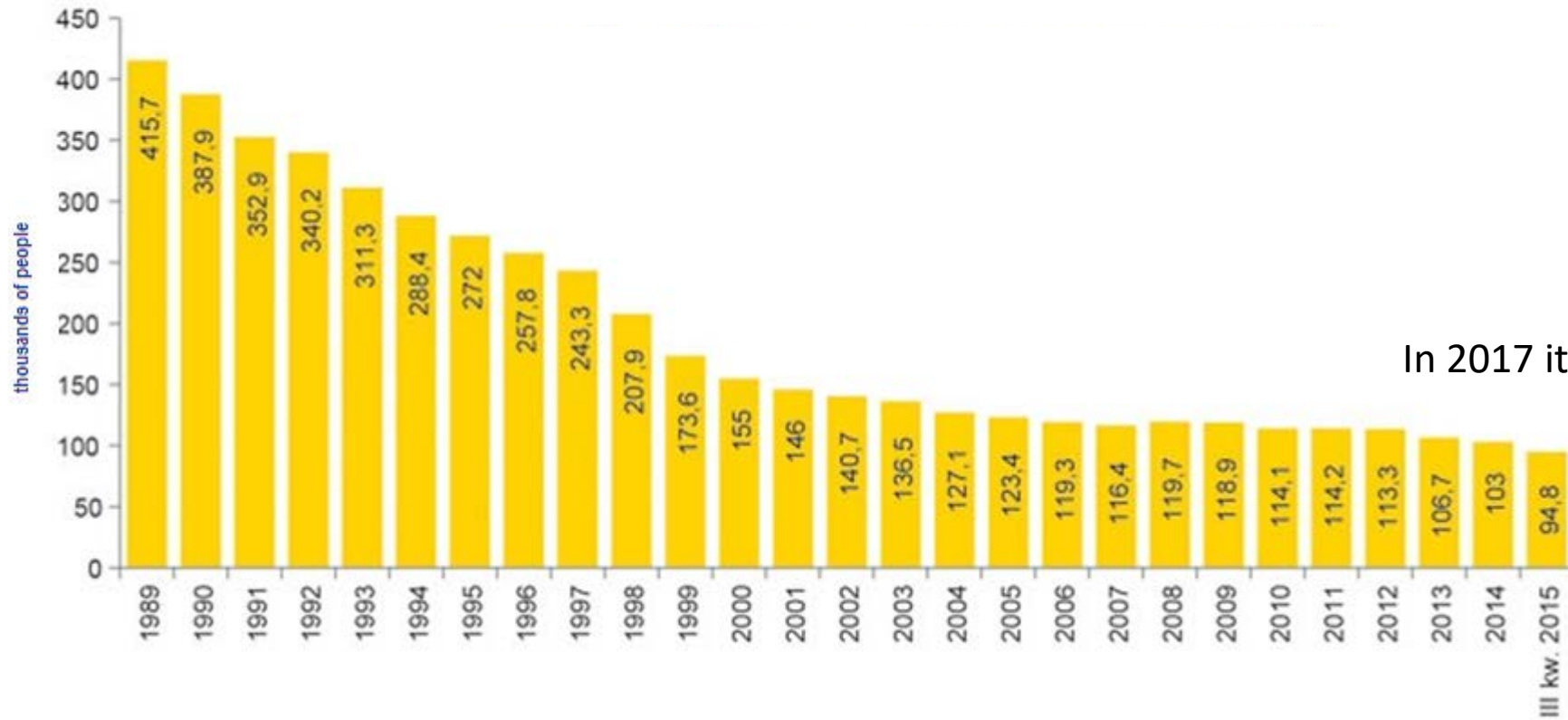
